Latvian Environment Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) will be hosting **27th Baltic Sea Ice Meeting (BSIM) in Riga 10-13 September 2018**. BSIM is intended for sea ice services, maritime administrations and icebreaker managers in the Baltic Sea region.
